TREASURY REPORT: By Juline Beier

\$4,145.28 in bank, but approximately \$3100 after expenses paid. Approximately \$2500 will be left after paying for postcards (\$567 for 6 1/2"x 11" postcard)

MINUTES: Approved from last meeting

SHOW DATES:

Show lasts three weeks only, Dec. 15 to Jan. 12th, with Jan. 13, 14th for cleaning & walk-through. While Presidio is closed Monday and Tuesdays, we can be open seven days a week if we want. Melissa reports no deposit.

A motion for keeping the exhibit open 7 days a week and Thursday nights 11am to 8pm was made and seconded. The majority passed this motion.

Christmas Eve and New Years Eve will close at 3pm.

SITTING THE GALLERY:

Obligation to sit once only. Two people sitting gallery each day like previous shows. Lucy and Regula are available for extra sitting.

Thursday evenings we need two more people from 5pm to 8pm.

For the reception night we need three additional people.

Guards do not have to be.

INSURANCE:

Allegra got a quote from Basic West Insurance Co. for \$540.20 for three weeks. Allegra will call the insurance company to try and reduce the amount .

BANNER:

Allegra is doing the banner. The metal structure for the banner is covered by trees, etc. Regula said to contact the Presidio to improve banner visibility. Regula will clarify with walk-through with Tia of Presidio Also, the electrician problems will be clarified at that time.

PUBLICITY: Lisa is handling publicity. There is also the Presidio Mailing List. Alex and Joanne Salz are working on magazines, newspapers, S.F. Chronicle, etc. and Cheap Fun.

Alex announced we have Facebook page now. Type facebook.com and open your account. Katy mentioned that we should give Lisa info for web site. Publicity you submitted such as your resume,etc. was for Jury Publicity, totally different now. We do not know if our submissions for Publicity are approved yet.

Alex said that 25 artists submitted publicity images. They made errors such as leaving out first name or last. People did not read instructions.

POST CARDS AND POSTERS

Melissa stated that we spent \$400 on mailing at the last show. Jennifer suggested E-vite for friends. Each person will get approximately 50 postcards to mail to their friend. We encourage E-vite.

Images are to be put into Dropbox (www.dropbox.com). Lisa wants one detail (possibly two if required). Images should be 300dpi, and 4x6.

Marty passed out Dropbox.com instructions at the meeting. She just sent an e-mail telling you how to do it.

The Presidio will not let us bring in our own food and wine.

We have to bring chairs and tables. Renting 20 chairs was \$170 or \$180. We will bring chairs from home. 31 people volunteered chairs. Alan Fishkin has two six-foot tables, and Sheila has one. There is one card table at the Presidio, and we may need two more tables. We figure three tables for the reception food and one for the wine, and maybe more.

Much discussion regarding wine ensued. It was decided that Phyllis can check a winery for a donation.

Reception Hours: 5-7pm

Presidio wants a holiday theme. Maybe cookies? We should invite the Board of the Presidio trust..

A motion to whether we should have the reception or not was made. Majority wanted the reception.

Caterer carries insurance.

THREE YEAR ART RULE:

Stuart brought up the idea that before we had a rule that artwork could only be two years old. It was voted that we can now have art work that is three years old. Also, last time we voted in that an artist can have only one series art piece. Marty's ten bowling pins will be OK.
